February 15, 2015 Transfiguration of Our Lord



Make plans to join us for the beginning of Lent as we observe Ash Wednesday on February 18 at 7 pm. This year we will meet at Epiphany and will be joined by our brothers and sisters from Parkway Presbyterian. Imposition of Ashes and Holy Communion will be celebrated.

Lent is traditionally a time when we pray, fast, and serve others as a way to prepare to celebrate Easter. Lent is 40 weekdays plus six Sundays and reminds us of the forty days Jesus spent in the wilderness. During the other Wednesdays in Lent we will gather for a simple meal at 6:15 and Holden Evening Prayer at 7 pm. The schedule is as follows:
