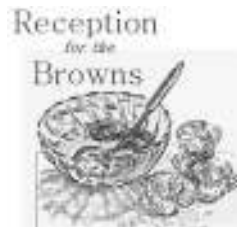
Pastor Laura Health Update

First, I would like to say thank you to everyone for the prayers, the cards, the offers of food after my recent hospitalization. I completed a four-day round of IV antibiotics March 12-16. Thankfully, by the time you read this I will have finished the 10-day round of oral antibiotics. Since the beginning of the year, I have been having a chronic flare-up of diverticulitis. Some of you may remember that I was hospitalized for this in 2008. Due to the chronic nature of this current episode and my history, I will meet with a surgeon on April 6th to schedule colon surgery. As soon as I have a date and more details, I will share that information with you. Currently I am on a very restricted diet, so thanks for the many offers of food, and soon I hope to enjoy the wonderful fruits of your labor.

I have been surrounded by your prayers and have felt the strength of them. I am thankful to be part of this community of faith.
