Summer Worship Notes

During the summer months, you may find that your life moves at a slightly different pace; our worship life will move into a different rhythm during summer as well. As we enter fully into the long green season of Pentecost, or Ordinary time, we will be using Setting Eight. This is a setting that we have used during previous summers. A few other things are shifting about our worship this summer as well. We are bringing back the Procession, so as the crucifer enters the sanctuary, please turn and face the cross. Our acolytes have been recently re-freshed in their training and have the important job of leading us as the people of God in worship. The gathered community always follows the cross; the acolytes carry that cross into our midst, and it is around the cross that we as the people of God gather.

Also, announcements are shifting to a little bit later in the service, right before the Children's Sermon. We have a natural pause in our liturgy here before we turn our attention toward hearing God's Word, and this will also give us an opportunity to note anything special that might be happening during our worship or during the upcoming week.

This will be a wonderful summer with faithful and engaging worship, and other opportunities to grow in our faith and deepen our relationships with each other and God. Make sure to mark your calendar for our summer kick-off immediately following the service next week. We will have a potluck luncheon after worship, so if you're planning to bring a liturgically color-coordinated jello salad, (as Lutherans often do) the color of the day is green. Looking forward to seeing you here this summer!
