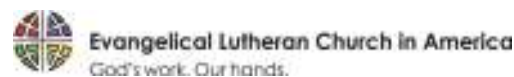

Sixth Sunday After Epiphany



Make plans now to join the youth for a **pancake supper on Shrove Tuesday, February 28th from 5:00 to 7:00pm**. This will kick off our Lenten season. All contributions will benefit the youth group.

Ash Wednesday is March 1st. We will have our **Ash Wednesday service at 7:00pm**.

Beginning *March 8th and every Wednesday evening through April 5th*, plan to join us for **Lenten Supper at 6:15pm, followed by Holden Evening Prayer at 7:00pm**.

**Holy Week** will begin with worship on **Palm Sunday, March 9th at 10:00am**. **Maundy Thursday, March 13th** we will have a Communion & Healing Service at *noon*, followed by our **Senior Lenten Lunch at 12:30pm**, hosted by the Nora Deal Circle. That evening, at *7:00pm* will be our **Maundy Thursday service**.

On *Friday, March 14th* **Stations of the Cross** will be offered at *noon* and our **Good Friday Service at 7:00pm** that evening.

Then comes **Easter!** There will be an **egg hunt** for the children at *8:45am on March 16th* and the Epiphany Builders will provide breakfast. Then the alleluja's will be back as we celebrate the **Resurrection of our Lord at 10:00am**.
